The Role

The Librarian/Learning Resource Coordinator (LRC) will play a pivotal role at Halstead St Andrew's in providing the day-to-day management, development and promotion of the School's library at both sites and facilitate access to both staff and pupils contributing to the School's learning objectives.

As the School's provision expands there is an expectation for this role to encompass the management of the Senior School Library/Learning Resource Centre.

A key aspect of the role is promoting reader development initiatives, including fostering a love of reading across all age groups. The Librarian/LRC will train both pupils and staff in the effective use of resources to enhance learning outcomes.

In support of the school's Literacy Policy, the Librarian/LRC will help maintain resources, provide advice to colleagues and pupils, and establish a visible presence within the wider learning community to ensure appropriate access to

learning materials.

Additionally, the Librarian/LRC will ensure that all ICT and audio-visual equipment is fully functional, reporting any issues to the IT Support Team promptly.

The role involves making the provision at both sites attractive and accessible to all by organising displays, events, and providing guiding and promotional materials.

Supervising and assisting pupils to ensure they are working effectively within the Learning Resource Centre is another important duty, along with supporting the induction of new pupils to the Learning Resource Centre.

The Librarian/LRC is accountable to the Head of English and may be required to undertake additional tasks that align with the broader responsibilities of managing the Learning Resource Centre.

The role is a part-time, term-time only. Monday to Friday 20 hours per week.
